An internship at a Pocomoke physician's office brought her to the Eastern Shore and eventually to her job as PA to Dr. Michael Atkins at McCready's Outpatient Center in Crisfield.

Becky's specialty is family medicine. "You get to know the patients and the things that happen in families over the years.

Her oldest patient is 94, the youngest, 16. She travels to Smith Island with her nurse, Jill Rayfield, to see patients. And she also makes house calls on the mainland, one of the area's few health-care professionals who does.

Their rustic Snow Hill farmhouse reminds her of the farm where she grew up.
